Carla Ann Behnke, 56, of Oak Creek, died on Thursday, January 11, 2018, at her home in Oak Creek.

She was born on November 27, 1961, in Fond du Lac, the daughter of Norman and Judie Gratton Behnke. She was a graduate of L.P. Goodrich High School, Class of 1980. She received an Associate Degree from UW-Fond du Lac and graduated with an education degree from UW-Stevens Point in 1984. She taught elementary school and nursery school in Fond du Lac for several years and managed a Coach House Gift Store for 5 years in St. Cloud, Minnesota. She was currently employed by UW-Milwaukee for 20 years. She started in the Chemistry Department before transferring to become a Fee Specialist in the Registrar's Office of Enrollment Management.
