Ada Hollis (Peg) Schave, aged 94, was called to her heavenly home on August 20 2021. She spent her first 17 years on the family farm before leaving to fulfill her dream to teach children. God provided for her when that seemed impossible. She graduated from Wood County Normal School in 1947. She taught two years in a one room school house before she married, and another two years before stepping away from teaching to become a stay-at-home Mom.

Peg re-entered teaching in 1958. Continuing with evening and summer school, she graduated in 1962 from Marian College with a B.S. in Education. She completed her formal education by earning her Masters Degree in Education (Guidance) from UW Oshkosh in 1971. Her last teaching assignment was Rosenow School. She retired in 1986.

Peg was an active member of Calvary Bible Church for many years. The highlight of her life was when she believed and trusted that Jesus Christ was both her Savior and Lord.
