



## Albert A. Dinse

December 7, 1928 - April 6, 2012

Albert A. Dinse, 83, of Lamartine, died Friday, April 6, 2012, at St. Agnes Hospital, Fond du Lac. He was born on December 7, 1928, in Oconto Falls, a son of Andrew and Anna Ritter Dinse. On May 21, 1955, he married Shirley Mae Henning. Albert served with the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict, and was a former Commander of Oakfield VFW Post 8092. Following his service in Korea, he worked for his uncle at Lamartine Creamery. He later founded Dinse Motors in Lamartine which he owned and operated until suffering a stroke in 1987. Prior to his stroke, he served as supervisor on the Lamartine Town Board, was a member of the Lamartine Fire Department for 28 years and served as assistant chief. He is survived by four children: Mike (Barb) Dinse of Oakfield; their children: Jonathan (Paula) Dinse and their son, Hutson; Bryan Dinse and his fiancée, Emily; Matthew Dinse; Linda (Norman) McEathron of Greenbush, and their daughter, Ashley McEathron; Jean Kaufman of Fond du Lac; and her children, Heather (Edward) Budler-Ronzoni; their children, Morgan, Julien, and Amaya Budler-Ronzoni; daughters Leanne Conklin, Kathryn Kaufman and step-son, Morgan Kaufman; David Dinse of Lamartine; his son, Andrew; two sisters, Lorraine Dinse and Carol (Dave) Drella, all of Krakow; two brothers, John Dinse of King and Ken (Dolores) Dinse of Green Bay; a brother-in-law, Andy Davidson of Georgia, and a sister-in-law, Lolly (Pete) Pleschek, of Gresham. He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Shirley on February 25, 2010; a grandson, Norman McEathron, Jr.; a sister, Ruth Davidson, and two brothers; Bill Dinse
