



## Ambrose M. Koenigs

September 14, 1919 - May 24, 2017

Ambrose M. Koenigs, 97, formerly of Malone/Johnsburg, passed into the hands of his Almighty Father on Wednesday, May 24, 2017, at the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home, with his family at his side.

On September 14, 1919, he was born to Joseph and Mary Diedrich Koenigs.
