Arthur E. Schierland, 77, of 577 Marshall Avenue, Fond du Lac, died Monday, June 21, 2010, at Aurora Medical Center, Oshkosh. He was born on April 30, 1933, in Fond du Lac, a son of Henry E. and Lynn Pearl Williams Schierland. Art was a graduate of Fond du Lac Senior High School, Class of 1951.
