Bruce L. Olp, 74, of Fond du Lac, formerly of Minocqua, died Friday, December 11, 2015, at Kindred Hearts, Fond du Lac. He was born on February 5, 1941, at home, in Fond du Lac, a son of Rodney E. and Gladys I. Hildebrandt Olp. Bruce served with the United States Navy on the U.S.S. William M. Wood. On June 13, 1959, he married Jeanne H. Dille in Dubuque, Iowa. He worked as service manager with Hansen Refrigeration and later was a resort owner in Minocqua.
