



## Carlton "Carl" H. Jacobs

November 15, 1926 - October 21, 2011

Carlton "Carl" H. Jacobs, 84, of Fond du Lac, passed away peacefully on Friday, October 21, 2011, at the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home. He was born on November 15, 1926, in the Town of Eldorado, a son of Harry R. and Frieda Abraham Jacobs. He attended schools in the Town of Eldorado, Winnebago Lutheran Academy, and Fond du Lac Vocational School. Carl served with the United States Army during World War II in the Asiatic-Pacific Operation with Division Headquarters of the 6th Infantry Division. On June 14, 1952, he married Gloria D. Farr at Immanuel-Trinity Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac. He worked for several businesses in North Fond du Lac and Fond du Lac, and in 1961, he began employment with the City of Fond du Lac. Carlton was an active charter member of Luther Memorial Church, Fond du Lac, and held various church positions, especially with the church choir and building and grounds. He loved gardening, the outdoors, and spending time with his family.
