



## Carol E. Jackson

March 28, 1935 - April 23, 2025

Carol Elaine Jackson, 90 of North Fond du Lac, died on Wednesday, April 23, 2025, St. Agnes Hospital.

She was born on March 28, 1935, in Green Lake County, the daughter of Benedict and Leona (Weber) Soda. Carol was confirmed at St. John's Lutheran Church in Princeton, in April 1949. She was a graduate of from Princeton High School, Class of 1953. On October 11, 1958, she married Robert J. Jackson Jr. at St. John's Lutheran Church in Princeton. He preceded her in death on February 25, 2021.

Carol was able to stay home and raise her children. After they had grown-up, Carol was employed part-time at the former Rolling Meadows Nursing Home, in the dietary department for 28 years, and part-time at Blanck's Lake Aire Supper Club. Carol was a long-time member of Zion Lutheran Church until it closed at the end of 2018, she then joined Redeemer Lutheran Church. She was a member of the Van Dyne Lioness Club since June of 1999, was awarded the Birch-Strum Fellowship Award in 2015, Honorary Lifetime Membership in June 2015, and certificate of recognition for distinguished service, loyalty, and devotion to objects of furtherance of Lionism and 20-year membership June of 2019.
