Carroll B. Kindschuh, 78, a resident of St. Francis Nursing Home, 33 Everett St., Fond du Lac, died Friday, May 23, 2008. He was born on February 2, 1930, a son of Benjamin H. and Elda B. Dehring Kindschuh in Fond du Lac. Carroll was a graduate of Lomira High School Class of 1948. He was especially proud to have been a football player on the team that won the conference title in 1947.
