Charles Arkadga "Chuck" Kulaga, 91, of Greenacres, FL, was born to eternal life on Wednesday, March 21, 2018, in Florida. Chuck "Charlie" was born November 1, 1926, in Fond du Lac, WI, the youngest child of Prokofe and Mary Prus Kulaga. He graduated from Fond du Lac High School and married Myra Gusse on May 8, 1948, in Fond du Lac, WI. They were married 67 years. Chuck and Myra (Dolly) relocated to Florida in 1987.

Chuck owned and operated several service stations in Fond du Lac, WI, primarily for Standard Oil, with his last service stations on 6th and Main and Highway 41 South. He was a distributor of home fuels in Fond du Lac. He later worked for Brenner Tank in Fond du Lac. In Florida, Chuck worked at Spanish River Resort in Delray Beach as Maintenance Supervisor prior to his retirement from work. He served in the US Army during World War II as a Sgt in Co "A" 106th Infantry.

His military occupational specialty was Message Center Clerk. Chuck enjoyed golf and later was an avid fisherman.

A wise and insightful man, he and Dolly raised four children and loved playing "Rummy" with friends and family. He enjoyed his family visits whenever they came to Florida.
