



Charles Richard Coffman

January 7, 1921 - May 26, 2009

Charles "Chuck" Richard Coffman, 88, entered Eternal Life peacefully at the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home on Tuesday, May 26, 2009. He was born on January 7, 1921, in Manitowoc, a son of William H. and Pauline T. Stillman Coffman. He grew up in Two Rivers, Cedarburg, Port Washington, and Fond du Lac. Chuck graduated from Fond du Lac Senior High School and on March 16, 1942, he joined the United States Army. He served in Africa, Sicily, and Italy. He was discharged on November 31, 1945 with the rank of sergeant. He received one service stripe, five service bars, an American Campaign medal, the European, African, and Middle Eastern Theatre ribbon with three bronze stars. On September 27, 1947, he married Gladys "Curly" T. Krug at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Town of Forest. Chuck was employed at Wisconsin Power & Light for seven years and was a machinist at Giddings and Lewis until his retirement in 1984. He was a member of St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church. He is survived by a son and daughter-in-law, Robert and Mary Coffman; a grandson, Christopher; nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Gladys on October 26, 1993; a brother, William Jr.; a sister, Florence (Jeffy) King; and his grandson, Ryan Coffman. The funeral service will be at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, May 29, 2009, at St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, 1600 South Main Street, Fond du Lac, with Rev. Michael J. Zuberbier officiating. Burial will follow in North Eldorado Cemetery. The visitation will be on Friday at church from 9:00 a.m. until the time of service. Memorials may be directed to St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church.
