Charles "Chuck" White O'Neil, 84, of Fond du Lac, died Friday, July 9, 2010, at Kindred Hearts of Fond du Lac. He was born on September 30, 1925, in the Town of Springvale, a son of the late Dale H. and Ruby L. White O'Neil. He graduated from Rosendale Union Free High School. Chuck married Mildred "Milly" I. Pucker on April 16, 1947, at St. Stephen's Lutheran Church, Rogersville. He worked as a dairy farmer, milk hauler, cheese factory employee, and as a sanitation engineer for the City of Fond du Lac. Chuck was the last surviving founding member of St. Stephen's Lutheran Church Brotherhood of Rogersville, and he was also a member of Mercury Marine Retirees Club. Chuck enjoyed hunting, fishing, gardening, playing cards, working on jigsaw and word puzzles, and watching sports (especially baseball and football). However, his greatest interest was his relationship he shared with his great-grandchildren.
