Chester T. McAuly, 91, died Thursday, March 26, 2009, at Walnut Grove Suites, Fond du Lac. He was born on April 4, 1917, in the Town of Ashford, Fond du Lac County, a son of Chester J. and Carrie Weidmer McAuly. On April 24, 1935, he married Helen W. Tettenborn at First Evangelical Lutheran Church, Ripon, with the Rev. Paul Kehl officiating. Chester was a farmer for 12 years. He then drove truck for over 34 years, with a 25 year perfect driving record, for Beck (Schlitz Beer), Darling Company, Olson Trucking, and Central Wisconsin Trucking. He retired on December 6, 1974. He was a member of Salem United Methodist Church, serving as a trustee, usher, and various parish and cemetery committees. Chester served the Lord on several work missions which took him all over the United States and Bolivia, South America. Chester was a member of the Friendship Class dartball team, a volunteer with Loaves and Fishes, and a former member of BPOE Elk's Lodge 57. He was an avid fisherman and spent many hours on lakes Winnebago and Poygan. He enjoyed playing cards and meeting his buddies for breakfast. He is survived by a son, Thomas C.
