



## Cora E. Warnke

July 13, 1914 - December 22, 2012

Cora E. Warnke, 98, peacefully passed into the arms of the Lord on December 19, 2012, at Grancare Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, Fond du Lac. She was born on July 13, 1914, in LaCrosse, the sixth of nine children to Charles and Alice Von Allmen. Cora married Henry Egli in 1934, where together they owned and operated a cheese factory in the Montello-Dalton area until Henry passed away in 1951. Cora later married Arthur Warnke and moved to Fond du Lac in 1952. Cora was employed at Wells Mfg. for 23 years and retired in 1977. She was a member of Luther Memorial Church, Fond du Lac. Survivors include her son, Charles (Virginia) Egli; a grandson, Michael (Lori) Egli; two great-grandsons: Tyler and Andrew Egli, all of Fond du Lac. She is further survived by nieces, nephews, a special niece, Edith Bottleman; and many friends from Luther Memorial Church, especially Rhoda & Gordon Krause.
