Darlene A. Drehmel, 79, of Wild Rose, formerly of Fond du Lac, died January 10, 2014, at Select Specialty Hospital, Madison. She was born on January 24, 1934, in Fond du Lac, a daughter of Benjamin Peter and Marguarite Evelyn (nee Voyacy) Walker. Darlene was baptized by John H.
