David R. Witt, 89, of Fond du Lac, died on Friday, August 11, 2023, at St. Francis Home.

He was born on January 19, 1934, in Ripon, WI, the son of Rueben D. Witt I and Josephine A. (Schneider) Witt. Dave was a graduate of Ripon Senior High School, Class of 1952. On December 26, 1953, he married Carol Mae Goyette, at St. Patrick's Church, in Ripon.

Dave worked at Johnson Good Year, State of Wisconsin DMV, 37 years in the Electronics Division at Giddings and Lewis, Wisconsin State Auto Auction (Midstates), D&X Services Stations, Biddle Motors and Moraine Park Technical College. He was a member of the following organizations: Coast Guard Auxiliary, Fond du Lac Yacht Club, Fond du Lac Sailing Club, Fond du Lac Boating Club, Amateur Radio of Fond du Lac, Sports Car Club of America (SCCA), Fond du Lac Corvette Club, Mensa, Mustang Club, and Fond du Lac Elk's Club. 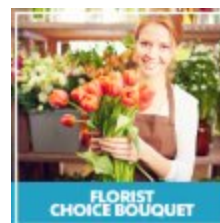
