Deborah “Deb” “Bobbie” K. Johnson, 68, of Fond du Lac, passed away one day shy of her 41st wedding anniversary to the love of her life, Richard, who pampered her and showered her with love till her last breath, on Sunday, December 8, 2019, at St. Agnes Hospital.
