



## Delbert "Del" A. Krumbein

March 3, 1940 - October 11, 2016

Delbert "Del" A. Krumbein, 76, of Fond du Lac, died Tuesday, October 11, 2016, at St. Agnes Hospital. He was born on March 3, 1940, in North Fond du Lac, a son of Arthur A. and Alice Rosenow Krumbein. Delbert was baptized on March 19, 1940, and confirmed on April 11, 1954.
