March 5, 1928 - November 21, 2014

Delmar Rudolph Kluball, 86, of North Fond du Lac entered his eternal rest in Christ on Friday, November 21, 2014. Delmar was born in Green Valley to Rudolph and Margaret (Steger) Kluball on March 5, 1928. He was baptized as an infant and confirmed as a youth in the Lutheran Church. He served in the United States Army during the Korean War. He was married to Verna Lea Hills on July 13, 1957. He worked as an electrician until his retirement in 1990.
