Donald Jerome Luby, 90, of Fond du Lac, passed away at Meadow Harbor Rehab on Friday, September 9, 2022.

Don was born in Fond du Lac, on November 4, 1931, the son of Kenneth and Marjorie (Beau) Luby. He attended St. Joseph's Grade School and St. Mary's Springs Academy. Upon graduating in 1950, Don joined the United States Marine Corps and served his country for 20 years. Don served in Korea and Vietnam and was stationed many places around the world, of which the tattoo on his forearm could attest too. Don met his first wife, Ruth, while he was stationed at Quantico. They were married in November 1963. Don retired from the Marine Corps in 1970 and opened his own bar and restaurant "Luby's" and also worked as an insurance salesman. Upon his wife's death in April 1972, Don moved back to Fond du Lac. He met Margaret Schultz Kelly and they were married in November 1972. Don worked at Mercury until his retirement. Don was a lifelong member of the Marine Corps League and VFW, and a former member of the American Legion. He was an avid and excellent bowler and golfer.

Don is survived by his daughter, Ruth Anne, his grandson Ryan, his sister Patricia Stewart, niece, nephew and cousins.

He is preceded in death by his parents, his first wife Ruth, his second wife Margaret, his brother Dickie, and numerous aunts, uncles and cousins.

Cremation has taken place. A private memorial is planned by the family.
