Donald F. Meyer, 81, a resident of Fond du Lac, died Sunday, September 12, 2010, at St. Agnes Hospital. He was born on May 2, 1929, in Milwaukee, a son of Fred and Ethel Corrigan Meyer. He graduated from Fond du Lac Senior High School, Class of 1947, and attended Wartburg College, Waverley, Iowa.
