Donald Edward Puls, a resident of 311 Boyd Street, Fond du Lac, died Thursday, August 7, 2008, at Agnesian Healthcare Hospice Home of Hope. Navy began during WWII, in March of 1944. He served on the USS Saint Croix APA-231 as a motor machinist's mate 3rd class. He received the Point system, Victory Medal, American Area Campaign Medal, Philippine Liberation Ribbon and the Asiatic-Pacific Area Campaign Medal. He was honorably discharged in June of 1946.
