



## Dorothy B. Koentopp

April 25, 1917 - September 12, 2009

Dorothy B. Koentopp, 92, formerly of Rosendale and most recently of Fond du Lac, died Saturday, September 12, 2009. She was born on April 25, 1917, in North Fond du Lac, a daughter of the late Edward and Rose Marquardt Gfrorer. On February 26, 1938, she married Alvin Wix at Immanuel-Trinity Lutheran Church. He preceded her in death on February 27, 1955. On July 10, 1963, she married Harold L. Koentopp. He preceded her in death on November 25, 1988. Dorothy was an inspector at Wells Mfg., a salesclerk at Grant's Department Store, worked at the Shopping Center in Rosendale, and volunteered at St. Agnes Hospital for over 20 years.
