Dorothy Mae Whittaker, 88, of 348 Hickory Street, Fond du Lac, passed away on Monday, March 28, 2011, at ManorCare Health Services, Fond du Lac. She was born on August 24, 1922, a daughter of the late Charles A. and Marcia L. Kindness Faul. On March 11, 1944, she married Louis W. Whittaker at Church of Peace with the late Rev. Karl Koehler officiating. Sadly, Louie passed away after a short 28 years of marriage, when Dorothy was 50 years old. She never remarried and always said, "no one could ever replace my Louie". Dorothy was a member of Church of Peace for over 50 years. She was active in many activities including Martha Society, Sunday school, counting money, messenger crew, choir mother for the boy's choir. She was "Mrs. Santa" for the church bazaar for many years and served as chairwoman of the bazaar and candy booth. Dorothy was employed for many years for Don and Alma Pike, Van's Bakery, Beer Hut, and M.P.T.C. She enrolled her 12 children at Franklin School under Lorena Bartel, principal, and she received an award for being in the P.T.A. for 25 consecutive years from 1949-1974. She loved her family and friends and will be remembered for making hand towels. She enjoyed sending out greeting cards to everyone. She loved the Fourth of July big family picnics, where she always made her famous German potato salad. Her last holiday of the year was Christmas and she made her famous popcorn balls for all to enjoy. Mom was the glue that gathered her family together and the force that brought her friends together. She made coming home for the holidays, reunions, and family picnics a tradition that the family will cherish

forever. Dorothy and her late husband, Louie, raised 13 children, their “bakers dozen” and they called them their angels.
