Douglas “Mac” W. McNinch, 77, of 192 Chestnut Street, Fond du Lac, died Friday, October 27, 2006, at his home. He was born on September 3, 1929, in Fond du Lac, a son of Theodore D. and Mabel Raiman McNinch. He was a graduate of Fond du Lac Senior High School, Class of 1949. Doug served in the United States Army National Guard for 21 years in the 32nd Red Arrow Division, 127th Infantry and was a charter member and past president of the Fond du Lac Red Arrow Club. On September 19, 1953, he married Nancy L. Wischnefski at St. Peter’s Ev. Lutheran Church with the Rev. Gerhard Pieper officiating. He was employed as an electrician with the City of Fond du Lac for 41 years until his retirement in 1990. Doug was a member of Redeemer Lutheran Church.
