Douglas J. Schaub, 68, of Fond du Lac, died at Harbor Haven, on Monday, June 27, 2022, after a courageous 18-month battle with Creutzfeldt-Jakob (Prion) Disease.

He was born on December 29, 1953, in Fond du Lac, the son of John and Betty Snyder Schaub. He was a veteran of the United States Army, where he was stationed in Germany. He worked for the U.S. Postal Service, as a mechanic, for 27 years in Milwaukee. Doug had his own business, Doug's Extreme Handyman's Service in Sussex, for a number of years. He was an avid recumbent bicyclist. In his early years he participated in bicycle races. He loved his dogs Daisy and Rose.

He is survived by his mother Betty Schaub of Fond du Lac, his sisters: Marge (Steve) Gabel of Mt. Calvary, Nancy (Jim) Hill of Fort Smith, Arkansas, Chris (Jim) Serres of Fond du Lac and Carolyn (Kevin) Knueppel of Fond du Lac, his friend and former wife Chris Schaub of Van Dyne, his uncle Bob Snyder, his nieces and nephews: Julie (Andy) Weber, Annie (Dustin) Tasch, Bryan Groesbeck, Corey (Todd) Hayden and Ben (Derrick) Serres, his great-niece Hazel Weber, and his beloved dog Rose.
