Douglas Gene Thompson, 59, of North Fond du Lac, died unexpectedly on Wednesday, June 29, 2011, at St. Agnes Hospital, Fond du Lac. He was born on September 2, 1951, in Fond du Lac, a son of Eugene L. and Marlene M. Klimke Thompson. Doug graduated from Rosendale Union Free High School in 1969.
