June 22, 1928 - March 25, 2012

Edna E. Putz, 83, of Fond du Lac, died Sunday, March 25, 2012, at Hospice Home of Hope, Fond du Lac. She was born on June 22, 1928, in Waumandee, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, a daughter of Oscar and Minnie Stuber Miller. Edna received her education to become a teacher at County Normal School in Alma, Wisconsin, graduated in 1947, and taught for seven years in rural schools. On June 5, 1952, she married Rev. Marvin A. Putz at St. Michael's Lutheran Church, Fountain City, Wisconsin. Edna was a devoted mother and supportive wife to her husband, who was a Lutheran pastor for 52 years.
