



Edward "Ed" W. Stuhr

June 17, 1945 - August 15, 2023

Edward "Ed" W. Stuhr, 78, of Van Dyne, WI (formerly of Two Rivers), passed into eternal life on August 15th after a battle with cancer.

Ed was born on June 17, 1945 in Wausau, WI, the only child of Harold and Dorothy Stuhr. He graduated from Mishicot High School, in 1963, and attended Milwaukee Institute of Technology 1964-1966.

Ed enlisted in the in the U.S. Army in 1967. He served 3 years active duty in the U.S. Army Security Agency with 1 year tour of duty in Vietnam 1968-1969. He served Manitowoc County as a Sheriff's Deputy from 1970-1999. Ed was a charter member of the Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 731, Manitowoc, serving as Vice President and on the Board of Directors. He was a member of the DAV Chapter 17, Oshkosh. He also served 6 years on the Manitowoc County Veterans' Service Commission.

Ed was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in North Fond du Lac. He enjoyed fishing, sturgeon spearing, woodworking and remodeling his cottage on Lake Winnebago. His greatest joy was time with his grandchildren reading, fishing or just being together.

He is survived by his loving wife, Barbara (Wiltzius) Stuhr who he married on December 23, 1972 at St. Joseph's Church in Fond du Lac; their children Kristin Mootz (Joel), Daniel Stuhr (Rebecca); grandchildren Ashlyn Mootz, Nathan Mootz, Silvia Stuhr, Edward Stuhr and Walter Stuhr; extended family and friends.
