Eileen Eulalia Cronin was born on January 13, 1918, in Bismarck, North Dakota, to Frederick and Albertina Grundstrom Cronin. She died peacefully from natural causes on November 5, 2011, in Fond du Lac, at the age of 93. She had been a resident of Fond du Lac County for 65 years.
