



## Elaine H. Middleton

December 12, 1918 - May 4, 2007

Elaine H. Middleton, 88, a resident of Brownsville, died Friday, May 4, 2007, at St. Agnes Hospital, following a brief illness. She was born on December 12, 1918, in Greenwood, Wisconsin, a daughter of Carl and Elsie Freiberg Halle. On August 17, 1946, she married Robert H. Middleton, Jr., in Fond du Lac. They lived in Milwaukee until 1960, before moving to Brownsville. Elaine was employed as a crane operator at Allis-Chalmers Company, Milwaukee, for 37 years, retiring in 1979. She was a member of St. Paul's Ev. Lutheran Church, Brownsville. Elaine served as a volunteer for the Dodge County Senior Meals program. She was an avid letter writer, reader, traveler, animal lover and enjoyed attending musical events. She is survived by one brother, Harold (Geri) Halle of Brownsville; and nephews who Elaine considered to be the sons she never had, Richard (Sandy) Zitlow and Donald (Barb) Zitlow, together with other nieces and nephews; one brother-in-law, Lester Zitlow of Knowles; one sister-in-law, Chris Halle of Killeen, Texas; and special friend, Linda (Gary) Smet of Fond du Lac; and by many friends. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Robert on October 15, 1993; two brothers, Carl and Norman Halle; one sister, Ruth Zitlow; and one stepson, Robert J. Middleton.
