



## Elaine G. Vorwerk

April 25, 1930 - June 13, 2023

Elaine Grace Vorwerk, 93, went home to her Lord and Savior on Tuesday, June 13, 2023.

On April 25, 1930 she was born premature at seven months, three weeks and weighed 3 pounds 9 ounces. She then spent six weeks at St. Agnes Hospital in a newly invented incubator. She was the daughter of Edward B. and Grace Robson Grahl. Elaine grew up on a dairy farm in Eden and worked at Mammoth Spring Canning Company in Eden from age 18 until her marriage. She worked during the canning season and stenciled cases in the warehouse. Elaine married Harold Vorwerk on November 20, 1965.

She was a beloved babysitter for her nieces and nephews. Elaine was active in her church, and she taught Sunday School, sang in the choir, and played her saxophone in the orchestra. She was an excellent seamstress, cook, and gardener. Elaine was the “go-to” person for family members needing help, and she often took care of the needs of sick parents and siblings.

She is survived by her loving husband of 57 years, Harold Vorwerk, her nieces: Kathi (Weiss) Carlson and Joan (Hafermann) Bradford, many great nieces, and great nephews.
