Elda A. Hankwitz, 93, of Fond du Lac, died Saturday, January 19, 2013, at the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home, where she resided the past ten years. She was born on September 7, 1919, in Fond du Lac, a daughter of Arthur and Adelia Breitenfeld Hankwitz. Elda was a graduate of Fond du Lac Senior High School and attended Fond du Lac Vocational School.
