



## Elisabeth "Betty" E. Wegner

November 26, 1921 - June 28, 2012

Elisabeth "Betty" E. Wegner, 90, passed away peacefully on Thursday, June 28, 2012, at The Woodlands Senior Park. Betty was the eldest of nine children, born on November 26, 1921, in the Town of Eldorado, a daughter of Harry R. and Frieda M. Abraham Jacobs. Betty was a graduate of Winnebago Lutheran Academy, Class of 1940. On October 4, 1943, she married Norman W. Hackbarth. He preceded her in death on August 10, 1962. She then married Carl F.
