



Erdyne A. Tabbert

January 31, 1918 - August 31, 2011

Erdyne Alberta Tabbert, 93, a resident of All About Life Rehabilitation Center, died Wednesday, August 31, 2011. She was born on January 31, 1918, in Dale, Wisconsin, a daughter of Ernest and Wilhelmina "Minnie" Beckman Braun. Her family eventually grew to four brothers and one sister. Erdyne lived in a number of locations during her growing years and completed eighth grade in a one room school house in Weyauwega. On June 22, 1936, she was united in marriage to Edward A. Tabbert at the Methodist Church parsonage in Ripon, Wisconsin. After marriage, they lived outside of Rosendale and Oakfield, before finally settling in Fond du Lac in 1952. They had two children: Marjorie and Sue. Besides her family responsibilities, Erdyne worked at Infant Socks and the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home doing kitchen and laundry work, retiring in 1974. She also assisted with farm work as needed. She enjoyed playing ball and cards. Erdyne was a member of Immanuel-Trinity Lutheran Church, Ladies Aid; W.E.A.L.C., was involved with Vacation Bible School and participated in Couple's Club. She is survived by a daughter, Sue A. Grahl of Fond du Lac; five grandchildren; great-grandchildren; great-great grandchildren; a brother, Rev. Gordon (Mary Nell) Braun of Moscow, Idaho, and a son-in-law, Lyle Roberts. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Edward on October 13, 2000; a daughter, Marjorie Roberts; three brothers: LaVester (Arlene) Braun, Willard (Ruby) Braun, and Marlyn (Melva) Braun; and a sister, Irene (Kenneth) Polenska.
