Eve Marie (Faust) Blum, 65, of Fond du Lac, WI, passed into the arms of her Lord and Savior on Tuesday, December 24, 2024, after a battle with cancer. Eve was born on July 5, 1959 in Oshkosh, WI to Gilbert and Virginia (Mueller) Faust. Eve married Stephan Blum on April 21, 1984 in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. Together, they raised seven children. During their 40 years of marriage, they were blessed with ten grandchildren and several fur grandbabies who had a strong preference for grandma. Eve treated her children and grandchildren like the most precious things in the world. Eve remained a loyal employee for Winnebago Mental Health Institute for 35 years before she retired to spend more time with her family.
