



## Fern G. Karls

Fern G. Karls, 101 years young, of the St. Francis Home, died Friday, July 31, 2015. On September 5, 1936, she married Edward M. Karls at Division Street Methodist Church, Fond du Lac. The couple celebrated their 68th wedding anniversary in 2004. Fern worked in the downtown Sears store in the sporting goods department for 25 years. She knew everything there was to know about guns, fishing gear, and bicycles. She could assemble grills, bikes, and everything else in short order. She retired in 1978. She was an active member of Covenant United Methodist Church for 92 years. She was also a past member of the Fond du Lac Eastern Star, Chapter 70. In the 1950's, she was a Cub Scout Den Mother. Fern enjoyed square dancing in the late '50's, big band dancing through the late '90's, bicycling, walking, cooking, and caring for her family. Fern always reminded her children, "if you don't have something nice to say about someone, don't say anything at all, and that we are all God's children". She was preceded in death by her parents, John and Margaret (Cantzler) Kindness; her beloved husband, Edward; three sisters: Ercel Pommerich, Margie Wrchota, and Arlene Kindness; and two brothers: Lyle Kindness and Stanley Kindness.
