Florence A. Sartori, 91, formerly of 575 East Tenth Street, Fond du Lac, died peacefully in the arms of her Lord on Thursday, May 17, 2007, at the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home. She was born on August 21, 1915, in the Town of Forest, a daughter of Christian and Caroline Krumm Immel. She attended St. Peter's Lutheran Grade School and graduated as valedictorian of Winnebago Lutheran Academy, Class of 1933. On May 19, 1936, she married Dante A. Sartori. Florence worked at Infant Socks and retired from A.C. Nielsen Company after 17 years. After her retirement, she taught bible class to the mentally challenged at St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church. She volunteered at the American Red Cross, Galloway House and Village, Senior Center and was a city poll worker. Her hobbies included writing short stories for the Fond du Lac Reporter, gardening, baking, traveling and taking care of her precious doggie, Barney, for 15 years. Florence was a lifelong member of St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac. She is survived by three sons and one daughter: Donald (Miyoko) Sartori of Boulder, Colorado, David Sartori of Cudahy, Philip Sartori of Sacramento, California, Jeanne (Ron) Krueger of Town of Menasha; ten grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband; six brothers: Walter, Wilbert, Clarence, Marvin, Earl, Harold; four sisters: Ella Seibel, Irmgard Rose, Adeline Poch, and Nelita Lueck. The funeral service will be at 12:00 noon on Monday, May 21, 2007, at St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, 35 East Second Street, Fond du Lac, with Rev. Jon N. Cox officiating.
