



Floyd R. Freiberg Jr.

December 17, 1944 - January 16, 2022

Floyd R. Freiberg Jr., 77, of Fond du Lac, died on Sunday, January 16, 2022, at his residence.

He was born on December 17, 1944, in Fond du Lac, the son of Floyd R. and Helen L. Keenan Freiberg Sr. He was a graduate of L.P. Goodrich High School, Class of 1963. He attended U.W. Oshkosh. Floyd served in the United States Air Force from 1966 – 1970 and was stationed in Bismark, North Dakota, and also in Mississippi, where he taught radar.

He worked with his family at Freiberg Home Improvements in Fond du Lac, and later owned/operated Freiberg Home Improvements in Oshkosh until 1996. He was a coach with Blue Line Hockey from 1976-1986. Floyd was a very active man enjoyed biking and kayaking. He enjoyed old cars and going to car shows. He was a member of Fond du Lac Eagles Aerie #270 BPOE.

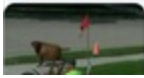
