Franklin W. Gronemeyer, 85, of Fond du Lac, passed away on Thursday, January 24, 2019.

He was born on August 3, 1933, in Germantown, the son of Alvin and Alma Hafemeister Gronemeyer. He was a graduate of West Bend High School. On May 4, 1957, he married Arleen N. Sachse, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Freistadt. They lived in Germantown for 39 years.

Franklin started work at the Germantown Lumber Yard, in Germantown. He then took a position as the head of maintenance at Range Line in the Mequon-Thiensville School District, where he worked for 34 years. He retired from there in 1995. Franklin spent 12 years as an Ozaukee 4-H Leader teaching woodworking to many youth. He was a talented furniture and cabinet maker and could make or fix anything wood. Franklin and Arleen moved to Fond du Lac 20 years ago. He was a member of Faith Ev. Lutheran Church, and was always willing to serve where needed as a volunteer. He enjoyed collecting toy tractors, model cars and clowns. Franklin enjoyed playing the accordion and listening and dancing to polka music.
