Fred A. Hansen, 79, of Delafield, WI, formerly of Fond du Lac, WI, died Sunday, June 22, 2008, at Waukesha Memorial Hospital, WI. He was born on March 4, 1929, in Wabeno, WI, and was raised in Fond du Lac. Fred served honorably with the United States Army during the Korean Conflict. He received both a Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees from Western New Mexico University. He then received a Master of Arts degree from Purdue University. Fred was a lifelong educator as he served in the capacity as a teacher and as a counselor. He retired in 1986 from Delta College, Saginaw, MI. Following his retirement, he moved back to Fond du Lac where he served as a substitute teacher in the Fond du Lac School District for five years. Fred married Victoria Zernia in 1999, and moved to Delafield. Fred is survived by his wife, Victoria Hansen of Delafield. He was a loving and caring father and he is survived by three children: Jeffrey (Rhonda) Hansen of Fort Collins, CO, Gregory (Cheryl) Hansen of Cedar Crest, NM, and Karen (George) Panos of Farmington, NM; two step-children: Carol (Douglas) Engebretson of Sterling, VA, and Al (Gail) Zernia of Rockford, IL; five grandchildren: Craig, Erik, Lily, Anders, and Robert; a sister, Shirley Durr of Sarasota, FL; and a step-sister, JoAnne Ward of Sister Bay, WI.
