George Thomas Trtan, 71, of 18 Schubert Lane, Fond du Lac, died Tuesday, July 31, 2007, at St. Agnes Hospital. He was born in Ironwood, Michigan, on February 29, 1936, the son of Jennie Perkovich Trtan and George Trtan. George attended the University of Detroit and the University of Wisconsin- Superior where he played football for Mertz Mortorelli. He commenced his teaching career in Belmont, Wisconsin. He retired from a satisfying and fulfilling career as a teacher and football coach from L.P. Goodrich High School in 1993. In his retirement, he enjoyed spending time with his family, watching his favorite sports teams (Go Bears!), discussing politics, and spending time with his friends: Harold and Joyce Cohen, Sal and Irene Curcurio, and his breakfast buddies. He is survived by his beloved wife, Beverly; a daughter, Kimberly (George Perez) of St. Paul, MN; three sons: Vincent of Middletown, CT, John and Jason of Fond du Lac; three beautiful granddaughters: Charlotte, Gabrielle, and Madeleine; two sisters: Mary Nantell of Ironwood, Michigan, and Ann Trtan of Oakland, CA; a niece, Carolyn (Gary) Nichols of Garden Grove, CA; two nephews, Jerry (Linda) Nantell of Indio, CA, and Bill (Judy) Nantell of Stevens Point, WI; and his cousins of Toronto, Canada.
