George Frank Weber, 85, of Fond du Lac, died Sunday, May 1, 2011, at Hospice Home of Hope, from a stroke. He was born on April 24, 1926, in Eldorado, a son of Frank and Magdalena Weber. George served with the United States Navy during World War II. He married Lois "Tootsie" Burger on July 27, 1946. She preceded him in death on September 1, 1989. On October 9, 1992, he married Virginia "Ginny" Rand. George retired from Mercury Marine after 35 years of service. He was a member of Church of Peace and the Elks Lodge B.P.O.E. #57. George loved gardening and was an expert woodworker, and he proved he could make or fix "anything".
