



Georgianna "Georgie" C. Meyer

February 22, 1920 - August 17, 2011

Georgianna "Georgie" C. Penning Meyer, passed away on Wednesday, August 17, 2011, at the age of 91. She had been residing at Tarfa Terrace at the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home for the past 4 ½ years, skilled nursing side 1 ½ months, and Hospice Care for the past 3 weeks. She was born on February 22, 1920, the third of five children to Alfred and Mary Ludwig Penning in Stockbridge. She attended St. Elizabeth's Grade School in Klotten. On August 12, 1941, she was united in marriage to Orville "Curley" Meyer at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Chilton. Georgie and Curley farmed in the Town of Forest/Dotyville area for 24 years before moving to Fond du Lac. Curley died on December 11, 1978, at the age of 61. Before retirement, Georgie cleaned homes, and worked at Howard Johnson's and the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home. She enjoyed cooking and baking, gardening, sewing, playing cards and bingo, and watching baseball games on television. Georgianna was a member of Holy Family Catholic Community and a member of the Holy Family Christian Women of St. Joseph's.
