



## Gerda Marie Strupp

May 15, 1926 - August 9, 2024

Gerda Marie Fahrendorff Strupp died on August 9, 2024. She was born in Milltown, Wisconsin (Polk County) on May 15, 1926, the daughter of Mabel Johnson Fahrendorff and Harold H. Fahrendorff.

In August 1934 she moved with her family to Taycheedah and attended a one-room school there. Gerda graduated from Fond du Lac High School in 1944 and from the State Teachers College in Oshkosh in 1948. While she was a student in Oshkosh, Gerda met Jerry Strupp and they were married on October 5, 1946.

Gerda was a long-time member of Hope Lutheran Church. She was active in many Fond du Lac community groups, including the League of Women Voters, Green Thumb Garden Club, and ParkWatch. She also was a volunteer at the Historic Galloway House and Village. She enjoyed various crafts, in particular quilting and rosemaling (decorative Scandinavian folk painting).

She is survived by her six children, twelve grandchildren, and seven great-grandchildren.
