Gerhard "Pete" A. Pflueger Gerhard "Pete" A. Pflueger, 93, a resident of 475 Roosevelt St., entered eternal life on Saturday, July 7, 2007. Gerhard was born on August 4, 1913 in Wrightstown, Wi., a son of the late August and Ernestine Rusch Pflueger. He graduated from Wrightstown High School in 1932. In 1940, Pete began his employment with the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad. On June 13, 1942, he married Marie Spietz at St. John's Lutheran Church in Wrightstown. The couple moved to Fond du Lac in 1945 after Pete became a track foreman for the railroad. He worked at various locations, retiring in 1975 after 35 years of service. Gerhard was a Charter member of Luther Memorial Church where he enjoyed being an active member. He is survived by his wife, Marie, of 65 years of marriage; one brother, Alfred (June) Pflueger of Wrightstown; one brother-in-law, Elmer (Frances) Spietz, of California; together with several nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by one brother, Elmer (Mary) Plueger and one sister, Esther (Leslie) Schmidt. The funeral service will be held at Luther Memorial Church, 134 21st St., on Wednesday, July 11, 2007, at 1:00 p.m. with the Rev. David Naumann officiating. Burial will follow at Ledgeview Memorial Park Cemetery. Visitation will take place from 11:00 a.m. until the time of service at the church.
