Gordon A. Pucker, 80, of Rosendale, died Thursday, March 27, 2008, at the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home. He was born on November 9, 1927, in Fond du Lac, a son of Albert Harold and Irma Irene Garb Pucker. On July 5, 1947, he married Alice C. Lange at St. Stephen's Lutheran Church, Rogersville.
