Haden J. Nimmer, 24, of Fond du Lac, died Saturday, May 31, 2014, at St. Agnes Hospital, following a lifelong battle with cystic fibrosis. Haden recently wrote, "Metaphors and imagery were used in my vows when Amanda and I married. I spoke of my condition that had tried to drown me for my entire life. I'd do that, gladly, drown beneath those waves, because she was the first thing in my life I was happy to have take my breath away."
