December 3, 1941 - June 4, 2011

Harlan "Catskinner" Immel, 69, of the Town of Forest, died Saturday, June 4, 2011, at Agnesian Hospice Home of Hope, Fond du Lac. He was born on December 3, 1941, in Fond du Lac, a son of Walter G. and Dora A. Becker Immel. Harley served in the United States Navy from 1958 – 1962, and married Verna M. Zimmerman on June 25, 1966. Harley worked as a dock worker at Galloway-West Company for six years and then drove truck at Tom Ottery Transit for another six years. He then operated heavy equipment for George S. Keys Construction and later for Andrew Excavating before he retired in 2006. He is survived by his wife, Verna Immel; three brothers: Vernon (Lila) Immel, Gordon G.
