



## Harvey W. Lange

October 7, 1920 - August 13, 2010

Harvey W. Lange, 89, a resident of Lakeview Estates, Fond du Lac, died Friday, August 13, 2010. He was born on October 7, 1920, in the Town of Oakfield, a son of William and Mary Hackbarth Lange. Harvey served with the United States Army as a Combat Engineer in the 103 Division from 1942-1943. On June 20, 1945, he married Beatrice Mae Kramer at St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church Parsonage, Fond du Lac. He worked at A & P Grocery in Oshkosh and Beaver Dam and then at the Fond du Lac Co-op in Brandon. He worked as an auto salesman for Schill Motors in Campbellsport for over 38 years from April of 1949 until December of 1987. Following retirement, he worked part time at Holiday Automotive and then Bergstrom as a courtesy driver. Harvey was a member of St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac, and was in their usher club. He was also a former member of the Estabrooks Cemetery Board of Directors and he volunteered at the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home for many years. He is survived by his wife, Beatrice; two daughters: Lois (John) VanWagenen of Plover, and Karen (Peter) McVey of Appleton; and a sister-in-law, Shirley Kramer of North Fond du Lac. He is further survived by many nieces, nephews, and cousins. He was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers: Kenneth Lange and Donald (Phyllis) Lange; two sisters: Gladys Lange and Bernice Lange; and a brother-in-law, Harold Kramer. The funeral service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 17, 2010, at St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, 1600 South Main Street, Fond du Lac, with Rev. Jon N. Cox officiating.
